

**Nursing Admission Requirements
Triton College
Application checklist for acceptance**

This check list serves to help the student keep track of the admission steps for the Associate Degree Nursing Program.

- Attendance at an information session highly encouraged
- Complete a Triton College Application.
- Complete a Nursing Application.
- Send proof of high school graduation to Triton College Records Department
- Forward official college transcripts to Triton College Records Department
- Nursing college credits from other universities cannot be transferred as credit towards program graduation
- Completion of a nursing pre-admission test (TEAS-Test of Essential Academic Skills);
- All placement test scores must be within the last two years;

Applicants should not apply to the Nursing program until they have successfully completed the prerequisites and preadmission courses for the program; Admission is determined by a point system based on a nursing pre-entrance test, Grade Point Average for college level preadmission courses (RHT 101, PSY 100, and BIS 241) and previous college academic history.
