Committee Updates

Academic Affairs (P. Jensen): The new Honda program will be starting in the Fall, will be going into T107 and will be prepper this summer.

Business and Facilities (G. Abezetian): Not present.

Technology Rep (M. Jason): We have the new Colleague interface U.I. 5 ready for users to view, so we are starting with some pilot test groups. They are able to use the current interface as well as the new one, while we make sure there are not issues with the new interface before rolling it out to campus. The new interface will have the same functionality, but a new look and no longer requires Silverlight to run. I.T. is also currently migrating the Colleague servers to new hardware and is testing the test servers and will do the production servers during off hours.

Human Resources (J. Klinger): The new proposals for performance standards are being reviewed, and we intend to have a version for the executive team after our next meeting. H.R. has been working with I.T. to coordinate spam/phishing training and that is scheduled to occur six times over the next three weeks in the PDC.
