

The Chicago School of Professional Psychology – Transfer Guide Bachelor of Arts in Psychology – Chicago Campus

The Chicago School of Professional Psychology – Chicago Campus is recognized by the Illinois Articulation Initiative as a receiving institution. Students wishing to transfer to TCSPP from Triton College will qualify for a block transfer of all general education courses at the Associate degree level.

A conferred AA/AS degree or a minimum of 48 Semester Hours of transfer credit are required for admission. All transfer coursework must be degree applicable and completed with a minimum grade of C or higher.

Students without a conferred Associate of Arts degree and have not completed the General Education Certificate will need to meet the following general education requirements:
